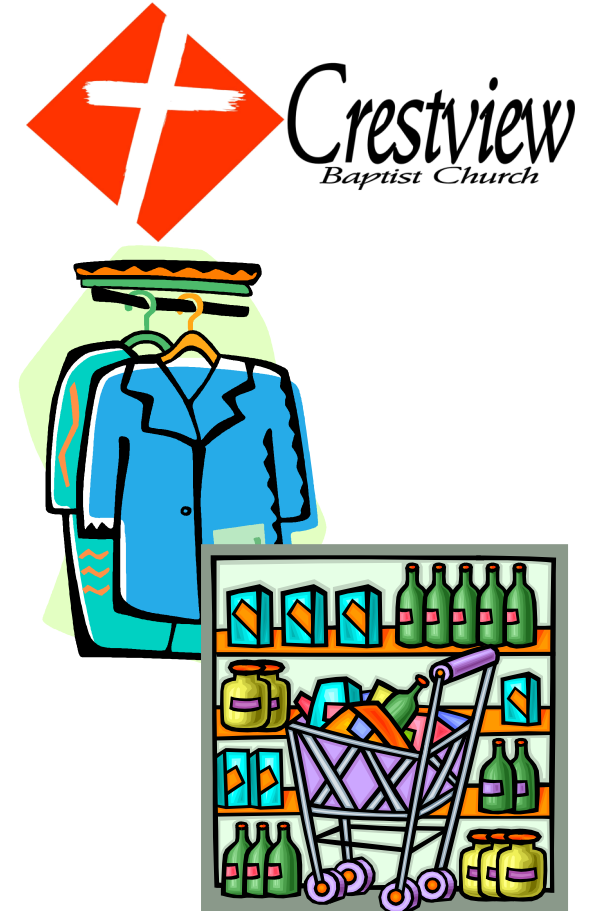

Our Ministry

In the book of Matthew of the Bible, Jesus taught a parable highlighting the importance of feeding the hungry and providing clothing to those in need. Of this kind of care for others Jesus said, *“Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me”* (Matt. 25:40). Crestview’s Clothing and Food Ministry is designed as a way for our church to fulfill the command to *“love your neighbor as yourself”* (Luke 10:27).

Clothing and food can be tremendous needs. However, we recognize that such are not anyone’s greatest needs. For it is an dreadful thing to be fed and clothed and not know the Lord. Being redeemed through the life-giving message of Jesus’ death and resurrection, is a person’s greatest need. With that in mind we are partnering with like-minded churches and ministries to share the gospel through the distribution of clothing and food to those in need.

Though our facility is not a distribution point, we serve as a collection point for members of our church to donate clothing and food. We then work with other local gospel-centered ministries who have the staff and experience to best distribute to the community. Donations can be left in the pantry during office hours or on Sunday mornings. Tax-deductible receipts can be obtained from the church office during normal business hours.
